RE: Zoning Permit #080309-3: to E&L Paving/Atlantic Paving

Dear Mr. Hayes and Ms. Bernich:

As previously mentioned to you (Ms. Bernich) in person, and to the Mayor and Administrator by letter of October 1, 2009, the above permit grandfathers a use which was never legal in the first place. Proof as to the previous use of the lots and actions taken against Mr. Bruno for illegal use of the lots is in your own files as demonstrated in a recent public records request I made. Legal action will be taken and official misconduct charges will also be sought.

I am also sure you know by now that another illegal use, i.e. operating a demolition and recycling business has also been instituted on those lots and is not even reflected in the aforementioned illegal permit. This noisy, dirty and unsightly use is having an especially deleterious effect on use of my property. The operator, Joe Rosario of Rosario Mazza Demolitions and Custom Lawn Sprinkler Co has also sought to block access to my parking lot by parking vehicles and placing equipment around the driveway entrance and made threats and threw rocks at my property and damaged my car to attempt to extort my acquiescence. As he doesn't belong here, Long Branch is partly responsible for these consequences. As also made known previously, Mr. Bruno as subdivider/developer never installed a cul de sac or provided for a 100 foot riparian buffer as required. I have had to load/unload chemicals in the street which is a potential public health hazard.

I especially urge you to stop this escalation of illegal use immediately and levy fines for each and every day it is continued.
